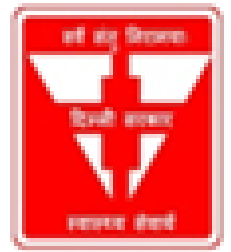
We continue to stand and work with our colleagues to ensure and adapt the course programme to reflect needs following the COVID-19 pandemic enabling you to support each other during this difficult times.
